# GETTING READY FOR SUMMER!

DEAR FRIENDS,

Change continues to be on our agenda and I want to keep you up to date as we progress. We are planning new ideas to be implemented this month for Sunday Brunch and our lunch menu. We also have a new service starting soon for our younger members.



We are delivering a new initiative with the Sunday brunch service and buffet. Our goal has been to offer a great value for this meal at only \$8.95 just as we have for the last four years. But even as the price stays the same, we need to change the menu. Serving an omelet and waffle station, and full breakfast buffet we know that we have to be creative to find a way to change that menu while staying cost efficient. In the last month or so, we changed the Eggs Benedict from the buffet to service a la carte. Keep in mind they're still included in the price, but now they have a fresh presentation. Also, the Chef has come up with a menu where three components will change each month thus keeping all the all the items you expect, and still provide some variety when you visit us regularly. We will publish those menus each month on our website and make them available around the Club. This month we will have a **Grit Bar** with Red Eye Gravy, Smoked Bacon, Cheddar Cheese, Red Onion, Jalapenos, and Diced Tomato. Also rotating in are Three Chili and Onion Hash Brown Pie, and Strawberry Cream Cheese Stuffed French Toast Casserole topped with

Toasted Pecans. Next month we will offer three different items to replace these and so on thereafter. While considering how to address the improvements to the brunch menu, we also worked on the availability of the lunch menu. Chef Shane has done a great job and this menu has become very

popular. The staff always works to accommodate our members, so we have begun serving the full lunch menu on Sunday during normal lunch hours. In addition, Chef Shane is adding some lighter fare to the dinner menu to satisfy those looking for a quick casual meal. You may have noticed the work on the **ladies locker room** recently where we have added a new entry door. That is because we are converting the lounge area to a **Drop-in Childcare** area. I owe a deep debt of gratitude to the Selva Marina Ladies Golf Association for their cooperation and assistance in completing this task. I am very excited about this new service enhancement and the increase in member usage of the Club amenities. We are still working out the details but we do need help getting the room ready. ## TURF TALK Golf Course Super., Chris Durkee

### SPRING IS HERE!

You are no doubt aware that over the past eight to ten weeks, we have experienced the coldest, extended, winter weather in Florida's recorded history. With morning temperatures averaging around 35 degrees, and even five straight days of lows in the 20's our TifEagle Bermudagrass greens have entered into a prolonged stage of dormancy unlike anything they have ever experienced. This dormancy, in effect means that the turf's life cycle has slowed so dramatically, we are unable to produce any type of repair and or recovery from foot traffic, ball marks, and maintenance.



In addition, these winter months have also been predominantly wet, overcast, and cloudy days that have severely limited the amount of sunlight the greens receive each day. These conditions not only make it impossible to grow quality turf, they are perfect conditions for growing algae and hilminthpithsporom (a leaf spot) disease, which we have had to consistently treat and manage. However, our root system below the turf canopy remains strong and this will lead us into recovery.

We have begun an aggressive campaign to reduce and/or manage these stresses and minimize their effects. You have no doubt noticed a switch to black topdressing sand during these winter months. This material is the same sand we use throughout the growing season, only it has been dyed black to attract and retain more heat throughout the day. The ability to raise the surface temperature just a few degrees above freezing can make a big difference.

You have also probably noticed at some point the tiny, pencil size aeration holes on all of our greens, collars and approaches.

# “RING THE BELL”



Typically, I am not one to “Ring the Bell” unless it is truly necessary. On behalf of Selva Marina Country Club I am “Ringing the Bell”. The Club is fighting through several issues: a very tough economy that has impacted us all and especially the Club; a loan that is maturing when it is very difficult to get credit of any kind; aging amenities that need improvements, and a changing marketplace where consumers want some products that we currently do not offer. We can survive all of this IF we come together to do whatever we can to help the Club.

As I discuss the Club with both members and non-members in the community, the recurring comment is what a shame it would be to lose the Club as part of our community. Selva Marina has been a part of the community since 1958. As one of our members put it, Selva is at a “Beauclerc moment”. Some may recall Beauclerc Country Club on San Jose Boulevard faced similar challenges that Selva is facing. Today, Beauclerc Country Club is called the Villages of San Jose, a residential community that sits on what was the golf course.

I am asking you to decide whether the statement “it would be a shame to lose this Club” is just words - or if the statement truly has meaning to you. And, if it does have meaning, ask yourself, “Is there anything else I can do?” Many of you are doing a lot already and I am thankful for your support. Many families have stayed with the Club even though it does not

offer everything they would like to have in a Club. Many members have stepped up to help us refinance the bank loan. Others use the Club often and are always helping us to recruit new members.

There are many ways to help but the one most pressing to the Club is refinancing its debt. The Club has a vision that remains valid and can be executed in time. But we do need time....time for the economy to recover to a point where people are interested in buying real estate again. Time until developers are eager to put capital back to work on what will be a great neighborhood. Our vision remains to reinvest every dollar generated from The Cove into improving our Club. If you feel like you can help by participating in the refinance of the debt please contact me immediately. In case you are not aware, a group of members have formed an LLC that is pooling funds to lend to the Club to pay off the Bank loan. The Club pays the participants of the LLC a 5% interest rate on the loan. The loan is secured by all of the Club’s property.

Don’t be mistaken; **I am “Ringing the Bell” for Selva Marina.** It is a great asset of this community that we should not lose. Join the LLC, recruit new members, utilize the facilities more often or do them all. Pulling together we can make it through these tough times.

Thank you for your support and I look forward to seeing you at the Club.

This process is very beneficial in many ways, primarily relieving compaction and allowing easier movement of oxygen and nutrients into the soil profile. It has also been effective at breaking up surface algae and along with applying some liquid algaecide/fungicides have helped us control these algae blooms, even during this exceedingly cold wet winter.

Finally, the most important and effective thing we can do to improve the most impacted greens (4,5,6, &8) is to reduce our tree canopy. These greens in particular simply do not receive enough sunlight during the winter months when the days become shorter, and the sun’s path is much lower in the sky. While we certainly realize that our trees play a huge role in defining our golf course, we are also losing valuable hours of early morning sunlight that are crucial for TifEagle Bermudagrass to flourish. I have identified the most impactful of these trees on those holes and we will be removing 12- 15 pine trees that will open up these greens to more sunlight, which will naturally eliminate algae and promote the recovery process.

While it is impossible to predict the weather (despite what Tim Deegan says) we are expecting these low temperatures to moderate into the 40’s through March and possibly see the 70’s during the day. Once this happens we can really begin to aggressively push top growth and root development and in combination with the steps we have taken above, we will really begin to see improvement and recovery rather quickly. Also, please know that we will be doing everything in our power to speed this recovery and resume the improvement of our playing conditions each and every day. Thank you for all of you’re understanding and support.
